AGREEMENT FOR TRANSFER OF CREDITS TO THE AMERICAN COLLEGE FROM MISSOURI STATE UNIVERSITY, SPRINGFIELD, MO

The American College and Missouri State University (MSU) agree to maintain guidelines outlining specific course transfers for students who desire to transfer course credits from MSU to The College. Both MSU and The College will make available to all interested students transfer information as outlined in these guidelines.

MSU students can transfer courses for credit into Huebner School designation programs offered by The College. However, students must take at least three courses from The College in the pursuit of a specific Huebner School certificate or designation.

The College will accept transfer credits from MSU students as outlined below. Satisfactory course completion must be documented on an official MSU transcript. Acceptable grades may include S, P, HP, or letter grades of “C” or better.

The College agrees to allow the following MSU courses to transfer for The College courses listed below:

Both MSU and The College have the right to modify any of the said courses at any time. If substantial modifications are made, each party agrees to notify the other and either party is free to amend this agreement as necessary.
